



# 2021 Shooting Stars Introduction Video Instructions

## WHAT TO WEAR

Options to consider: suit or coat, necktie or not, please, no t-shirts. Also consider either a dress or pants and a nice blouse, and make sure your hair is out of your eyes. Make sure all clothing fits well and is cleaned and pressed! You can also coordinate accessories: jewelry, neckties, etc.

## VIDEO BACKGROUND SETUP

Film your introduction video against a neutral backdrop, like a white, light colored, or black wall or sheet. Make sure you set up good lighting that illuminates your face but doesn't create harsh shadows.

## FRAMING THE VIDEO

Please film yourself so that the video shows you clearly from the waist up. This way we can see all of your beautiful and handsome faces!

## WHAT TO SAY

When recording your Introduction Video be sure to clearly state your first and last name, high school, the teacher who nominated you, and which category you are auditioning for. For example: "My name is John Smith, I go to Hollywood High School and my nominating teacher is Mrs. Brown. Don't forget to smile!

## HOW TO SUBMIT

Once you have your video uploaded to YouTube and marked as UNLISTED (not private), copy that YouTube link and upload it in your personalized Google Doc link (provided by ACJC).

- Performing Arts Finalists will be uploading two separate video links, one link for your Introduction Video and one link for your Audition video

## CHECKLIST

- Check for proper lighting
- Wear the appropriate clothing
- Film on cellphone or video camera
- Upload video to YouTube  
Mark as UNLISTED (not private)
- Check that video link works
- Submit Introduction Video link to ACJC
