<input type="radio"/> <b>Intonation</b> - Consider: accuracy to printed pitches	
<input type="radio"/> <b>Rhythm</b> - Consider: accuracy of note and rest values, duration, pulse, steadiness, correctness of meters	
<input type="radio"/> <b>Technique</b> - (facility/accuracy) Consider: artistry, articulation, attacks, releases control of ranges, musical and/or mechanical skill	
<input type="radio"/> <b>Interpretation, Musicianship</b> - Consider: style, phrasing, tempo, dynamics, emotional involvement	
<input type="radio"/> <b>Other Performance Factors</b> - Consider: choice of music, appropriate appearance, poise, posture, general conduct, mannerisms
