

Performing Arts: Theatre Performance Scholarship Guidelines

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Due to concerns surrounding the spread of COVID-19, live auditions will not take place. Instead, ACJC will utilize online video auditions for the 2021 Shooting Stars. The deadline for videos to be submitted is 11:59 PM (CST) Saturday, January 30, 2021. Audition videos must be filmed to see the Finalist's full body against a neutral background.

- 1. Audition must be minimum of five (5) and maximum of seven (7) minutes. The video will be cut off if maximum time limit is reached.
- 2. Finalist should make audition repertoire selections only after careful review and discussion of the Theatre Performance Scholarship Guidelines, Scoring Rubric and Audition Preparation Tips with their nominating teacher and/or private instructor.
- 3. Finalist must perform two (2) contrasting selections, either 2 monologues or one monologue and one song.
- 4. Finalist who choose to sing a song can perform a cappella or with piano accompaniment/pre-recorded accompaniment. Finalist is responsible for securing accompaniment/pianist or pre-recorded accompaniment for audition video.
- 5. Emphasis during audition must be on presentation and performance. As in previous Shooting Stars live audition years, Finalists may use a chair as a prop. Additional set pieces and costumes are not permitted.
- 6. Finalist must provide copy of musical pieces for judges, AND/OR must provide a copy of each monologue selection for judges. Photocopied music of monologues will be accepted.
- ** Note: Copy of musical piece provided for judges must be written for Finalist's choice of accompanied or unaccompanied music.
- 7. Auditions must be solo presentations; other students may not perform with Finalist.
- 8. Finalist and accompanist should be the only ones featured in the audition video.

Instruction for recording and submitting your audition videos:

- Videos can be made using a cell phone, computer, or other audio/video device. Please make sure to test audio quality before recording and eventual submission.
- You may record your excerpts on separate tracks (and take as many takes as you like). However, all must be compiled into ONE video submission.
- Upload your video to YouTube and mark as UNLISTED (not private).
- You will provide the YouTube link for ACJC and judges.
- It is highly recommended that you test your YouTube link by having at least 2-3 other individuals open and check for you.

Late or incomplete submissions or failure to meet all Participation Requirements or Scholarship Guidelines will result in immediate disqualification from the Shooting Stars Scholarship Program.
