<input type="radio"/> <b>Vocalization</b> – Consider: pace, phrasing, vocal tone	
<input type="radio"/> <b>Understanding of the Text</b> – Consider: connection from page to stage, action and intent	
<input type="radio"/> <b>Connection to the Audience</b> – Consider: timing, blocking of piece etc
