



What to Know About the 2022 Shooting Stars Gala

All Finalists participating in the Shooting Stars Recognition, Scholarship and Awards Program will be recognized and scholarships awarded at the Shooting Stars (SS) Gala. The 2022 Gala will be held at the Midwest Trust Center's Yardly Hall at 4:00pm on April 3, 2022.

Finalists and their families are invited to register for the gala as guests of the Arts Council of Johnson County; Finalists have no charge and receive four complimentary reservations to use for whomever they would like to invite. Other invited guests include Nominating Teachers, principals, school district officials, elected county and state representatives, and Shooting Stars supporters.

It is important for Finalists to attend. They are individually recognized onstage at the gala, will be handed certificates, and scholarship winners will be announced. No scholarship recipients will be announced prior to the Gala.

How to Register

Finalists, parents, and teachers will receive a Gala invitation email towards the end of February with instruction on how to RSVP online through Eventbrite. Once registered, Finalists, parents, and teachers will receive a confirmation email from Eventbrite with details about the Gala.

What Time Will the Gala Start?

There will be a short reception at the Nerman Museum of Contemporary Art before the Gala, starting at 3:00pm. At 4:15pm the event will begin with opening remarks from the Emcee of the evening and the Arts Council of Johnson County Board President. The Gala will go through each category recognizing all 2022 Shooting Stars Finalists and at the end of each category will announce the 1st and 2nd place scholarship winners.
