<input type="radio"/> Performance Technique – Consider: Mechanics of hand/arm motion, attacks and releases, pedaling execution, roll quality, rudiment types/sticking patterns, dampening, posture, intonation, instrument height	
<input type="radio"/> Rhythm/Note Accuracy – Consider: Attention to rhythm/ note accuracy and rests, correct interpretation of meter, duration, accidentals.	
<input type="radio"/> Interpretation/Musicianship – Consider: Phrasing, balance, emotional involvement/ intensity, finesse, interpretation of style	
<input type="radio"/> Expression/Dynamics – Consider: Adherence to markings, sufficient contrast between volume levels, attention to musical high points	
<input type="radio"/> Tempo – Consider: Attention to metronome marking, control and maintenance of basic pulse and subdivisions	
<input type="radio"/> Tone Quality – Consider: Playing area, choice of sticks or mallets, correct method and consistence of tone, head/snare tension	
<input type="radio"/> Other Performance Factors – Consider: Stage presentation, general conduct, poise, mannerisms, appropriate appearance, suitability of music, sensitivity of interaction with accompanist
